



THE HEADLAND HOTEL DOG POLICY

At The Headland Hotel & Spa Torquay we are happy to welcome well behaved friendly dogs. We do however ask that owners follow the guidelines below when bringing their dogs to stay with them, to ensure the comfort of not only them and their dogs but all guests.

- £15 per dog per night is charged for your dog to stay at The Headland Hotel & Spa, Torquay. If your dog has an accident and the bedroom requires maintenance or cleaning, there will be a surcharge for this, pricing list is available on request.
- A maximum of two dogs per room are allowed.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times within the public areas of the hotel.
- Please remember to clean up after your dog.
- Be mindful of other guests in the hotel, as some guests may be wary of dogs.
- We do not allow dogs on any furniture or beds, so please remember to pack suitable bedding for your furry friends.
- Dogs are not allowed in our Romanoff Restaurant or Gallery Bar, should you wish to eat with your dog, we have set aside the foyer in our hotel reception for you to enjoy your meals with your dogs.
- We are happy for your dog to be left unattended in your room, if you are confident, they will not become stressed in their new environment. Please display the "dog door hanger" showing that there is a dog in your room, at all times, thank you.
- Please contact reception on extension "0" to arrange a convenient time for your room to be serviced (between the hours of 09:00 to 13:00). For the safety and comfort of your pet, Housekeeping will only enter your room if your dog is not present.
